

1. I worship Shri Jayendra, supreme among Gurus, whose forehead glows with lines of Bhasma (Vibhuti); whose saffron apparel shines like the Sun at dawn; who is Chandra with pleasing speech of nectar, bathed in with gentle smile.

2. I worship Shri Jayendra, supreme among Yatis (Sanyasis), who, by his very look of shower of nectar of great compassion, protects devotees, roasted in misery, prostrating to him; who removes their endless ignorance (and grief) completely.

I worship with all my heart Shri Jayendra, supreme among Munis (sages), who took birth in the holy Agrahara in "Tamohari" (Irulneekki, dispeller of darkness) village, and dispels the darkness of ignorance of multitude of disciples; who, appropriate to his name, is ever accompanied by Jayashri (Lakshmi of Victory).

self-controlled, who awakens (to knowledge) people in slumber (of ignorance) for their wellbeing; who wishes all comfort even for the poorest; who makes people unwearied (in their efforts at spiritual advancement).
