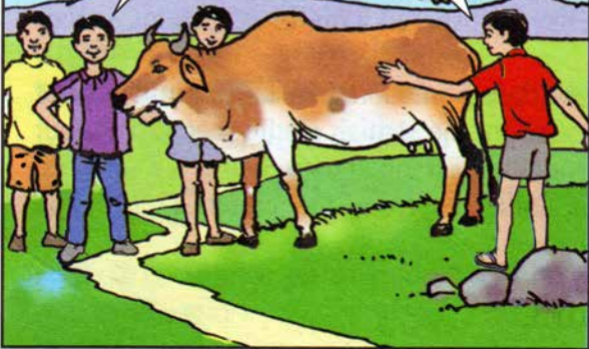


1. COWS SAVED A LIFE

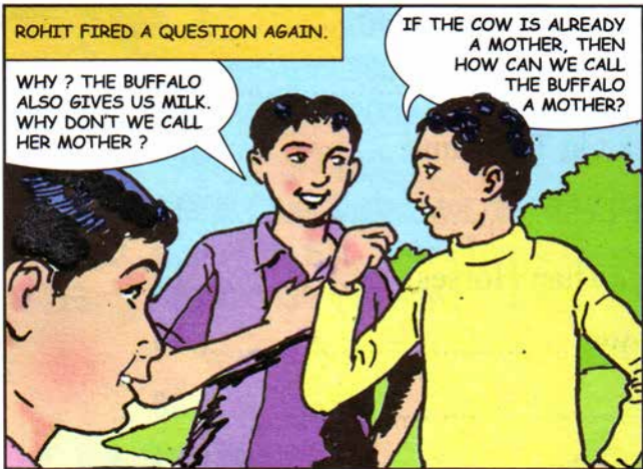

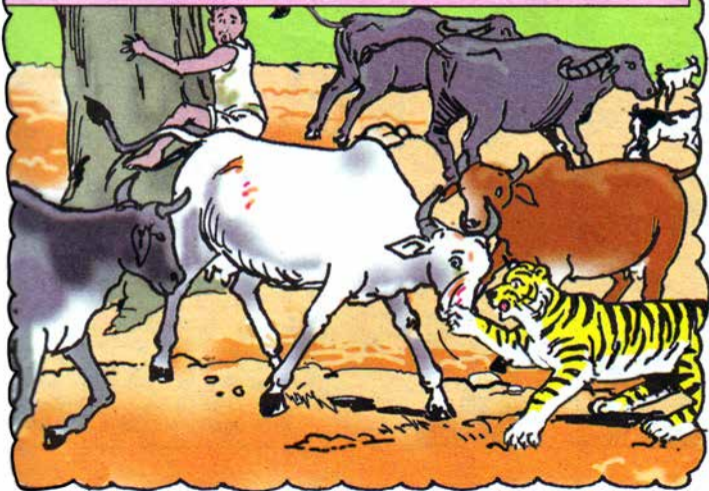

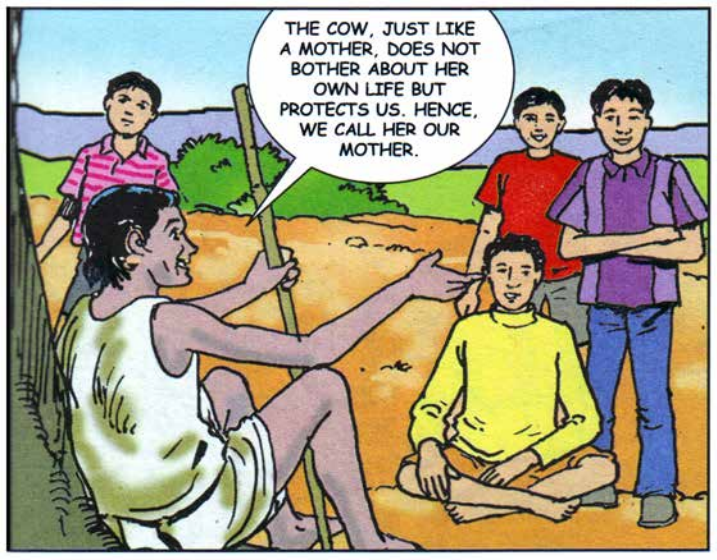


FINALLY THE TIGER
