

॥श्रीगुरुवातपुरीशपञ्चरत्नस्तोत्रम्॥

This stotra was composed by Brahmasri Sengalipuram Anantharama Dikshita in praise of the Lord of Guruvayur. It arose spontaneously in his mind when he was worshipping the Lord in the Guruvayur temple. He says that by reciting this stotra with devotion everyday one becomes free from worries and suffering and attains prosperity.

कल्याणरूपाय कलौ जनानां

कल्याणदात्रे करुणासुधाब्धे।

कम्ब्वादिदिव्यायुधसत्कराय

वातालयाधीश नमो नमस्ते॥१

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1. Prostrations to the Lord of Guruvayur who bestows prosperity on humanity in this Kaliyuga, who is an ocean of compassion, and who holds in his sacred hands the divine weapons such as the conch, etc.

नारायणेत्यादि जपद्भिरुच्चैः

भक्तैः सदा पूर्णमहालयाय।

स्वतीर्थगाङ्गोपमवारिमग्न-

निवर्तिताशेषरुजे नमस्ते॥२

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2. Prostrations to the Lord whose great temple is ever full of devotees loudly chanting "Narayana" and other sacred names, and who removes all the sufferings of devotees who immerse themselves in His holy tank whose waters are like those of the Ganga.

ब्राह्मे मुहूर्ते परितः स्वभक्तैः

सन्दृष्टसर्वोत्तमविश्वरूप।

स्वतैलसंसेवकरोगहर्त्रे

वातालयाधीश नमो नमस्ते॥३

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3. Prostrations to the Lord of Guruvayur whose majestic Visvaroop (cosmic form) is revealed during the Brahmamuhurta to his devotees standing all around Him. The oil with which He is anointed eradicates the diseases of those who apply it on their bodies and imbibe it.

बालान् स्वकीयान् तव सन्निधाने

दिव्यान्नदानात्परिपालयद्भिः।

सदा पठद्भिश्च पुराणरत्नं

संसेवितायास्तु नमो हरे ते॥४

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4. O Hari! Prostrations to You are worshipped by devotees who protect their children by giving them the divine rice in Your august presence and who constantly read the gem among Puranas, the Srimad Bhagavatam.

नित्यान्नदात्रे च महीसुरेभ्यः

नित्यं दिविस्थैर्निशि पूजिताय।

मात्रा च पित्रा च तथोद्धवेन

संपूजितायास्तु नमो नमस्ते॥५

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5. Prostrations to You who give food to Brahmanas everyday, who are worshipped every night by the gods, and who are worshipped by Your father and mother as well as by your dear friend and devotee, Uddhava.

अनन्तरामाख्यमखिप्रणीतं

स्तोत्रं पठेद्यस्तु नरस्त्रिकालम्।

वातालयेशस्य कृपाबलेन

लभेत सर्वाणि च मङ्गलानि॥६

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6. Any one who chants this hymn composed by Anantharama Dikshita daily at the three sandhyas will attain all auspiciousness by the strength of the grace of the Lord of

Guruvayur.

गुरुवातपुरीशपञ्चकारख्यं

स्तुतिरत्नं पठतां सुमङ्गलं स्यात्।

हृदि चापि विशेत् हरिः स्वयं तु

रतिनाथायुततुल्यदेहकान्तिः॥७

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7. All prosperity will be attained by those who chant this gem of a hymn named Guruvatapurisa panchakam. Hari who has the splendour of ten thousand Manmathas will Himself enter and abide in their hearts.
